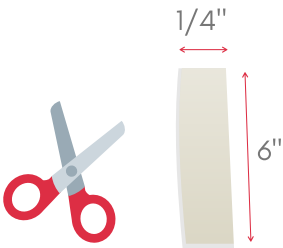
Find Your Ring Size Without A Printer

Having issues with figuring out your ring size? No worries! We've provided this simple step-by-step on how to check your ring size right from the comfort of your home. Getting started is easy and won't require any pesky printers.

Things you will need

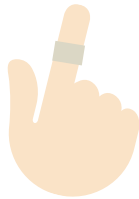
- 1 piece of paper (8.5" x 11")
- 1 pen
- 1 ruler
- 1 pair of scissors
- The sizing chart at the bottom of this page

Four Easy Steps



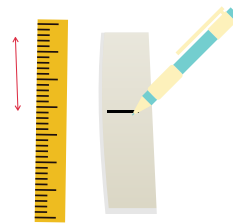
STEP 1

Cut out a rectangle of 1/4 inch wide and 6 inches in length.



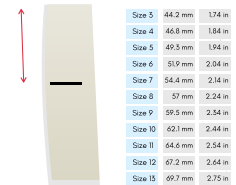
STEP 2

Wrap this strip of paper around your finger and mark exactly where it overlaps.



STEP 3

Now measure the distance from the end of the paper to where it was marked.



STEP 4

Take your measurement and check the sizing chart for size.

Sizing Chart

Size 3	44.2 mm	1.74 in
Size 4	46.8 mm	1.84 in
Size 5	49.3 mm	1.94 in
Size 6	51.9 mm	2.04 in
Size 7	54.4 mm	2.14 in
Size 8	57 mm	2.24 in
Size 9	59.5 mm	2.34 in
Size 10	62.1 mm	2.44 in
Size 11	64.6 mm	2.54 in
Size 12	67.2 mm	2.64 in
Size 13	69.7 mm	2.75 in

Helpful Hints

- Fingers change size during the day—measure your fingers at the end of the day when they are their largest.
- Finger size also changes with temperature; measure your finger when it is moderately warm.
- If your finger doesn't fall directly into one size, choose the larger size.
- Fingers tend to be one half-size larger on your dominant hand
